

NET components, for example, you can use Visual Studio code editors to build rich experiences for Windows desktop, Windows Store, and Web apps. Two of the UK's largest recycling companies, Corb and Berkeley Group, will merge in an £85m deal in a bid to secure contracts from major construction companies, the UK's Competition and Markets Authority (CMA) has revealed. Corb and Berkeley Group operate between 500 and 1,000 recycling sites, including Corb's 400-strong network of kerbside collection facilities, the CMA said. "The merger is expected to result in higher overall operating costs and reduce competition," the CMA said. "Berkeley's annual revenue has been in the region of £110m, and Corb's has been in the region of £150m, so you could imagine the volume that comes with that," the CMA's chief executive, Andrea Coscelli, told reporters on Tuesday. The CMA said that the merger would give Corb "superior access to networks and contacts" and help it win contracts from major construction companies. It added that the deal was not in response to any current loss of business by Berkeley to Corb, but was "a historic merger that has nothing to do with the specific case". UK competition regulator Andrea Coscelli Credit: PA The planned merger is expected to take place by the end of 2019, pending shareholder and regulatory approval. "We will be monitoring the new company and the market," said the CMA's Andrea Coscelli. "We will also be monitoring the anti-competitive effects of the merger." Berkeley Group has already said that it is considering potential offers for its recycling business, including a takeover by Corb, and Corb's chief executive has described the industry as "fragmented" and "dysfunctional". The CMA's intervention in the industry comes after it warned in February that recycling firms were colluding to keep prices high and reduce recycling rates. The watchdog said it had uncovered hundreds of cases of possible collusion in the past two years, affecting around 30% of all waste in England. Do you work in the recycling industry?
